A Protection Officer on Written Directions of the Magistrate, shall :



Conduct home visits



Make a preliminary enquiry

File a report on emoluments, assets, bank account, documents



Restore possession of personal effects (gifts/jewellery) of aggrieved and shared household



Assist in enforcement of orders of the court



Assist in regaining custody of children or secure rights to visit them under supervision of the protection officer



Protection Officer also Helps Victims of Domestic Violence by:

Providing information to a victim about her rights



Assisting her to make application for relief from court

Gaining free legal aid
